## Open classroom for self-study in the evening before section examination

- ◆ Date of high school mid-term examination: October 13, 14, 2022 (Thursday, Friday)
- ◆ Opening dates for evening self-study (five days before the exam and the day of midterm exam): October 6th (Thu.), October 7th (Fri.), October 11th (Tue.), October 12th (Wed.) and mid-term exam October 13th (Thu.), 2022.
- ◆ If a class that violates the rules of evening self-study is recorded by the teacher, the evening self-study of the class will be canceled.

## **©** Regulation for evening self-study:

- 1. Staying in school for evening self-study is regarded as a regular class, and should be in line with the school's dress code.
- 2. Please do not chat in the classroom during the evening self-study time.
- 3. Please do not use contraband (such as playing cards, chess, game machines, electrical appliances, etc.) during the evening self-study.
