

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) – School Uniforms

Q1: What should I do if I miss the purchase time?

A: You may purchase or exchange uniforms during the following hours:

- Dates & Time: Aug 18 (Tue) and Aug 20 (Thu), 12:00 PM – 1:00 PM
- Location: Activity Center, 4th Floor (Drama Stage)

Q2: Can I change the quantity of my uniform order?

A: Yes, students may adjust the purchase quantity based on their needs.

Q3: How many days a week do students need to wear the school uniform?

A: It depends on each homeroom teacher's classroom policy. However, students must wear PE uniforms on days with physical education classes and full standard uniforms on all other days.

Q4: Do students have to wear the school uniform every day?

A: Please refer to the school's Dress Code and Appearance Regulations (<https://reurl.cc/QNXE2o>).

Q5: Can I use my own backpack?

A: High school backpacks are optional (available by pre-order). For junior high school students, purchasing one is recommended.

Q6: Can I exchange uniforms if they don't fit after I bring them home?

A: Yes. Please ensure items are unwashed, clean, and undamaged, and bring them during the exchange hours.

Q7: What should I do if I ordered too many or not enough uniform items?

A: You may adjust your order during the uniform exchange hours, or visit the snack bar about a week after the new semester begins.

Q8: Can I buy summer and winter uniforms separately?

A: Yes, but buying them together is recommended so you can have your Student ID embroidered all at once.

Q9: What should I wear on the first day of school if my uniform doesn't fit?

A: You may temporarily wear your junior high or elementary school uniform / sports uniform.

Q10: What are the details for Student ID embroidery?

A: On-site embroidery service will be available on Aug 15 (Sat) from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM.

- Fee: NT\$40 per item.
- Embroidered uniforms will be handed out during New Student Orientation.

Q11: How do school meal plan payments and ordering work for freshmen?

A: Grade 10 freshmen will sign up for August and September school lunches on Aug 18 (Tue) during Orientation. Meals will be provided starting on the first day of school.

- Payment: NT\$1,575 per person.
- Payment will be collected by class representatives on Sept 2 (Wed) and submitted to the designated location.

Q12: Can students bring packed lunches from home? Are there food warmers on campus?

A: Yes, parents are encouraged to pack lunches for students, and classrooms are equipped with steam meal warmers. To ensure balanced nutrition and food safety, ordering food delivery is not encouraged.

Q13: Is there a uniform purchase subsidy for low-income families?

A: No, there are currently no subsidies available for uniform purchases.
